 (2) Semiautomatic pistol with a fixed magazine holding more than 10 rounds

 (1) Semiautomatic centerfire rifle with a detachable magazine and any of the following: any grip directly below the action of the weapon, a forward pistol grip, grenade or flare launcher, telescoping stock, or flash suppressor  
 (2) Semiautomatic centerfire rifle with a fixed mag. holding more than 10 rounds  
 (3) Centerfire rifle that has an overall length of less than 30 inches  
*If it's a shotgun...*  
 (1) semiautomatic shotgun that has both a telescoping stock and any grip directly below the action of the weapon  
 (2) semiautomatic shotgun that has the ability to accept a detachable magazine  
 (3) shotgun with a revolving cylinder
